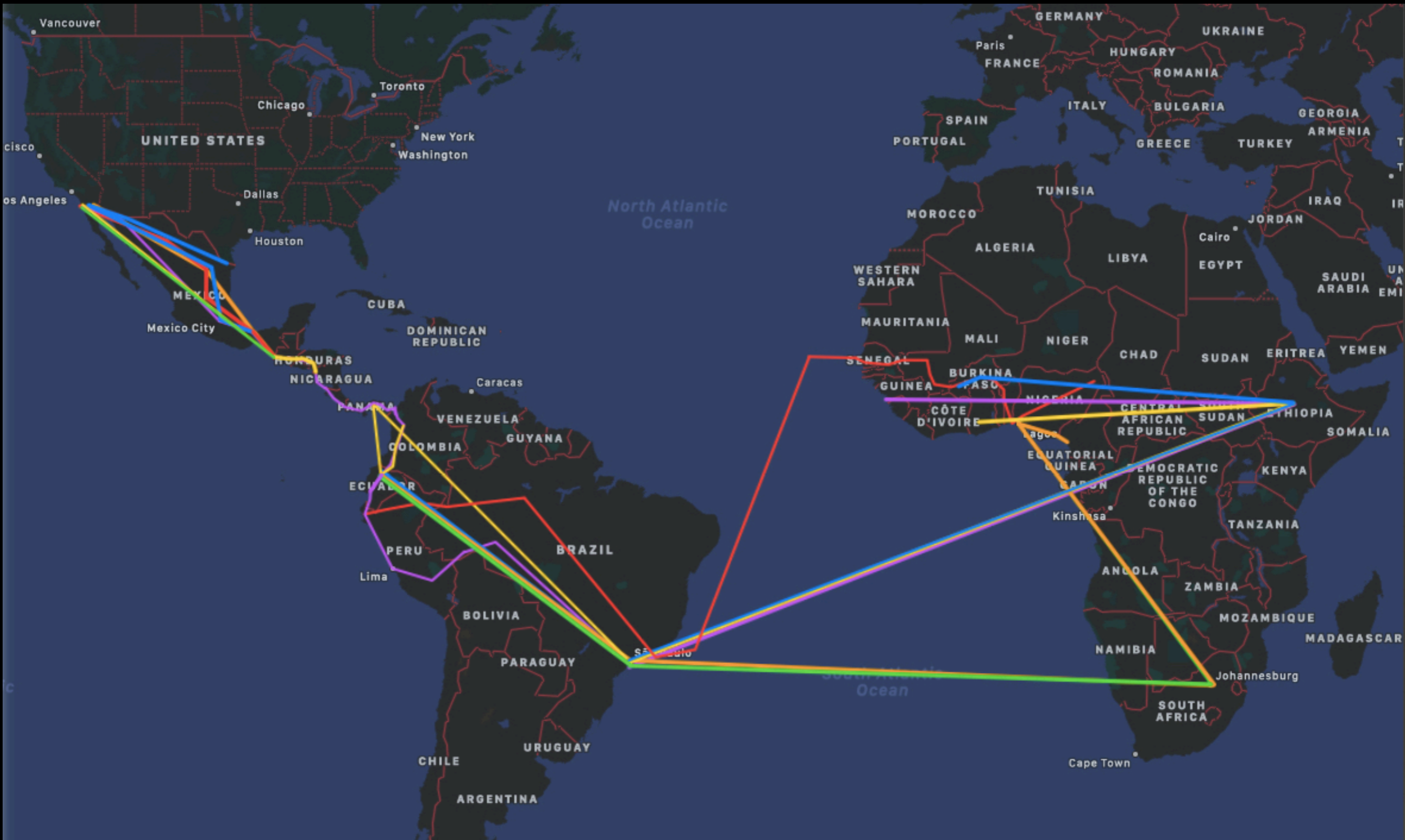


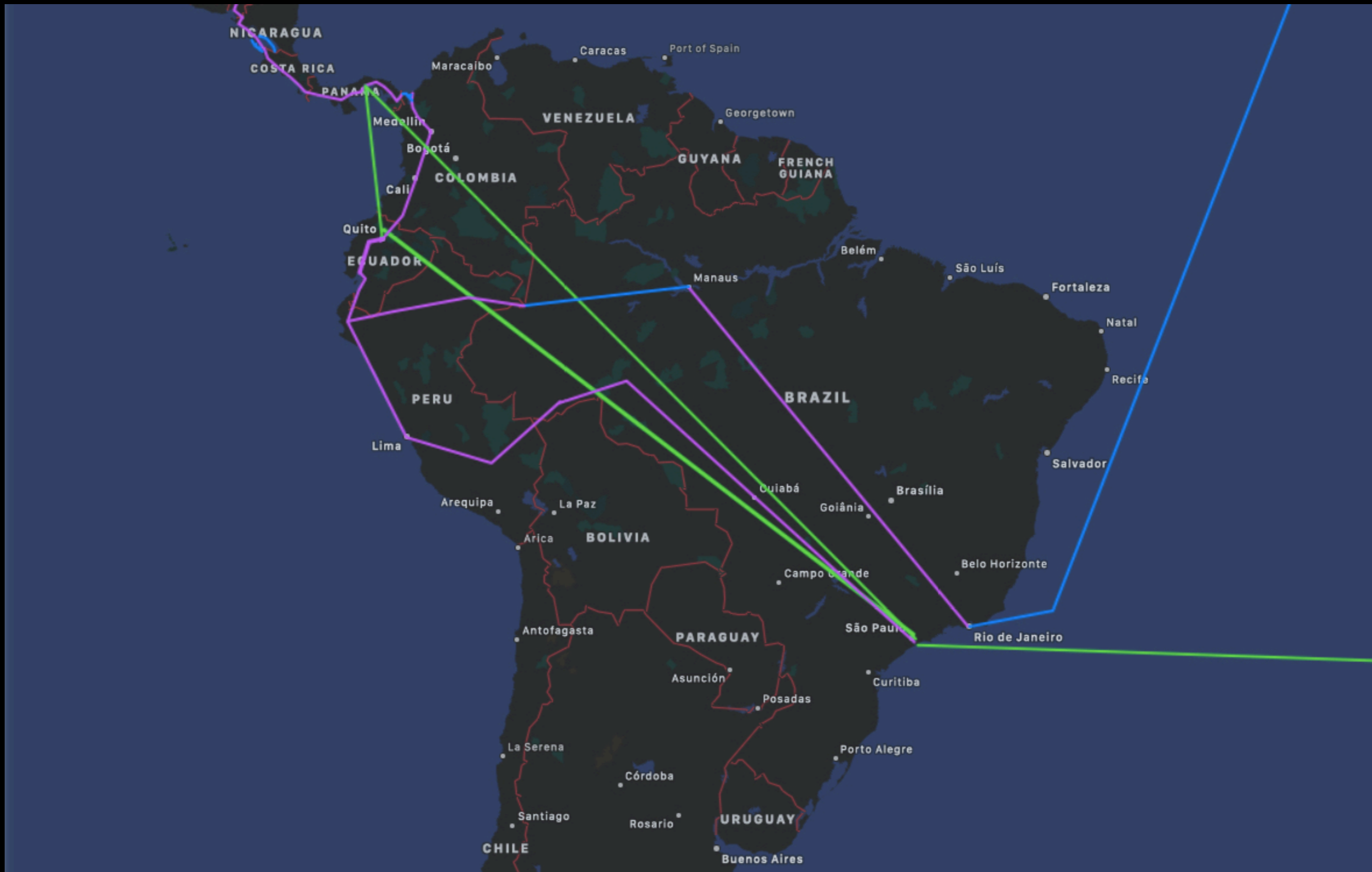

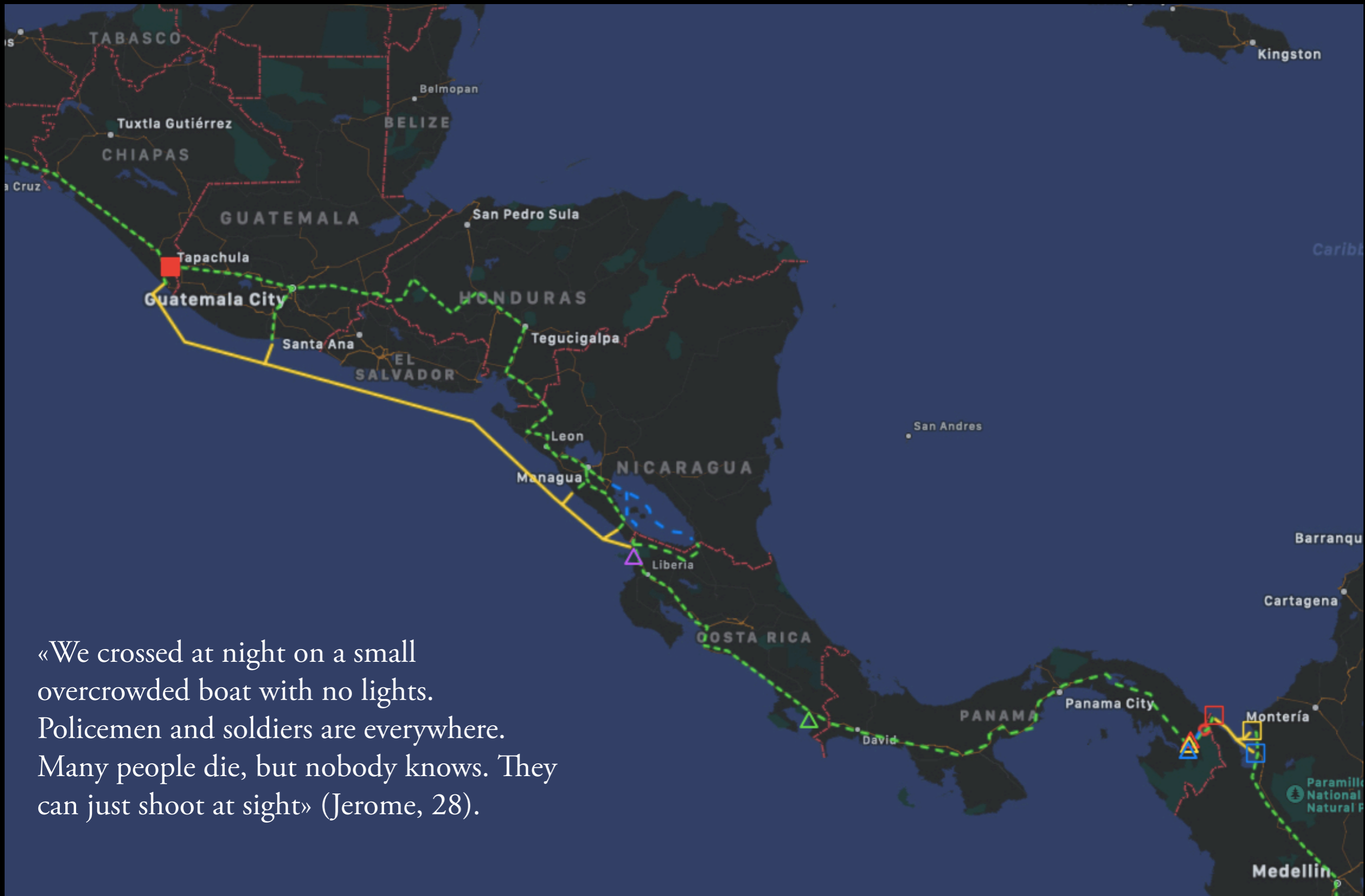




Water routes Air routes Land routes

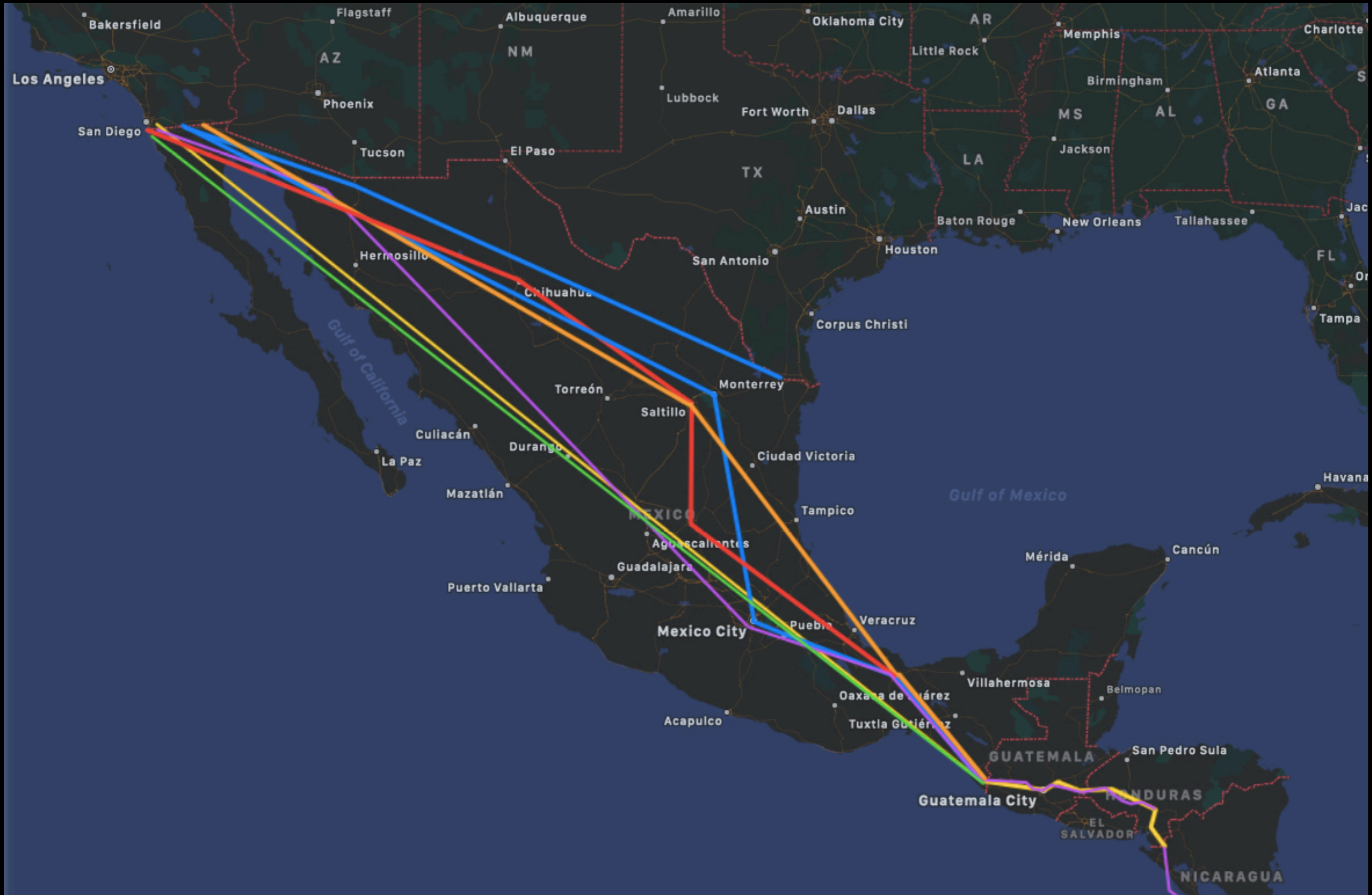
